Director presented precise introduction of PCET, Ten (10) Institutes under the umbrella of PCET situated near renowned Industrial Area of Pimpri Chinchwad as Pradhikaran Nigdi, Ravet and Talegaon Campuses, latest addition in the form of 'Pimpri Chinchwad University (PCU) at Sate which has started functioning from Academic Year 2023 – 24 and very fondly about PCET Trustees with a special mention of their continuous guidance and support; for new Members on CDC.

- Regarding concerning Admissions scenario for B.VOC (Solar) it was suggested to receive guidance from MEDA and other organizations of repute working in the domain and contacting Solar Companies with Proposals like Skills Enhancement Programs
- Regarding Experts to be nominated by Governing Body on Academic Council for Computer, AI & ML and Information Technology (Data Science); Members suggested contacting Dr. Ajay Deshmukh in addition to reaching out to other Experts.

Suggestions –

1. Considering Academic commitments (30 hours / week) of M.Tech. Students, they can be associated with Laboratory activities and Research Projects for 6 – 8 hours per week which will provide them with exposure and learning avenues in addition to justifying investments made in the Stipend
2. Computer Engineering Program (Regional Language) being offered and executed successfully is an achievement which needs to be published and branded thoughtfully
