- Regarding NBA for PG Engineering Programs, it was informed that Pre qualifier would be submitted first to know the eligibility and then the final decision can be taken after critical review of the strengths and weaknesses.
- Regarding closure of MBA Program, it was mentioned that SPPU has appointed Committee for Visit and other related formalities.
- Regarding receiving Autonomous status, it was informed that we can look forward to receiving the Official Communication in March 2020 and then further related formalities would be completed with SPPU and DTE (for change from Tier II to Tier I Institute) from Academic Year 2020 – 21. Other related preparations are already in progress.

- Considering the Industry requirements further focused efforts are required to be invested for Training and Aptitude.
- Association of Faculty Members with Industry needs to be strengthened. 1 Faculty associated with 3 Industries is the minimum target.
