

The NSS volunteers attended the session to learn about Ahilyabai's legacy. The session offered a meaningful reflection on her significant role in shaping social welfare and cultural heritage.

2. Speakers' Session:

Both sessions were highly insightful, but due to time constraints, the event had to be shortened. A speaker who was a Prakul Guru addressed the audience briefly, summing up the themes of both presentations.

3. Focus on Ahilyabai Holkar:

The central theme of the event was to honor Ahilyabai Holkar's *samajik* (social) and *saunskruti yogdan* (cultural contributions). Ahilyabai is revered for her progressive governance, social reforms, and the construction of numerous temples and dharamshalas (rest houses) across India. The speakers highlighted her leadership qualities, compassion, and her efforts in advancing social welfare during her reign as the Queen of the Malwa Kingdom.

4. Concluding the Event:

The event concluded with a formal vote of thanks extended to all the speakers, participants, and volunteers. Unlike their typical organizational duties, the NSS volunteers from Savitribai Phule Pune University attended the session as participants. Their role was to understand Ahilyabai's contributions and to listen to the speakers' perspectives on her historical and cultural impact.

Key Highlights:

- To foster community engagement by involving students, faculty, and local businesses in a collective act of giving.
- To promote the spirit of Diwali as a festival of light, unity, and generosity, ensuring its values

extend beyond personal celebrations.

- The donation drive ran for 4 weeks from 30/9/24 to 26/10/24. Throughout this period, donations were collected from students, faculty, and local businesses.

 - ➤ Sweet 2kg
 - ➤ 5 caps
 - ➤ 1 baby blanket
 - ➤ 18 shoes pairs
 - Volunteers worked in teams to sort and package the donations into individual kits.
 - Each family received a food package, a set of clothing items, and Diwali sweets. Children from the orphanage received cloths, books along with Diwali sweets.

The Diwali Donation Drive was a successful initiative, with substantial contributions made by the college community and a significant positive impact on the beneficiaries.


Out of various categories in the competition, PCCOE volunteers proudly represented the university in the following traditional cultural forms:


- The event commenced with an **inaugural** speech by **Prof. R.T. Jagtap** emphasizing the importance of public speaking skills.




