Key points covered during the session included:

- Framing assessment questions that map appropriately to Course Outcomes (COs) and Program Outcomes (POs).
- Balancing question papers to address all cognitive levels as per Bloom's Taxonomy.
- Implementing fair and transparent evaluation methods in an autonomous setting.
- Practical examples of designing assessments that foster higher-order thinking and application skills.

The session saw active participation from faculty members across all departments, who engaged in discussions, asked queries, and shared their experiences related to assessment practices. Dr. Bewoor's insights provided practical directions for enhancing the quality of internal and end-semester assessments to ensure they are robust, outcome-driven, and aligned with the NEP2020 vision.
