1. Confirmation of minutes of IQAC meeting -I held on 3 Aug 2024

Dr. Varsha Harpale, IQAC Coordinator welcomed all members of IQAC and briefed about IQAC meeting -II agenda points.

Dr. Harpale briefed minutes of IQAC meeting- I held 03 Aug. 2024 for approval. Minutes of IQAC meeting -I were approved and confirmed by all members.

2. Review of Odd Semester Academic Year 2024-25

Dr. Harpale continued her presentation with the achievements including:

- Institute Rankings and Achievements
- Department Achievements-Students and Faculty- Computer, E & TC, Mechanical, Computer-Regional, CSE-AI-ML, Applied Science Information Technology, Humanities, and Civil Engineering
- Student's achievements in various clubs like TIFAN, Team Maverick, Anantam, etc.
- Institute Activities as Best Practices in PCCoE

3. Review of QPs and QLs for Odd Semester Academic Year 2024-25

Dr. N. B. Chopade, Dean, Administration, presented Quality Parameters for administrative functions including budget distribution and utilization targets of 90% and 80% and also highlighted the current girl student enrolment rates with female faculty/staff ratio and respective QLs.

Dr. Kaustubh Sakhare suggested to keep girls scholarship target instead of girls enrollment ratio. Dr. Deshmukh elaborated the existing efforts about the girls scholarship. Girls are benefited scholarships like Lila Poonawala Foundation, Katalyst Scholarship etc.

Dr. Sakhare also recommended to conduct separate placement drives for girls. Dr. Rawandale, Dean III discussed the requirements of company where only girls students are eligible and PCCoE conduct these placement drives scrupulously.

Dr. K. Rajeswari, Dean Academics shared Quality Parameters and target for academic performance. She presented average CGPA target was set at 8.15 and achieved 7.73 and academic audits achieved 80.83%. Improvement in Academic Performance Index for F. Y.- T. Y. B. Tech Engineering is observed as 6.79, 6.83, and 7.11 respectively with success rate 9.09.

Dr. G. N. Kulkarni, discussed the KSA distribution in PO attainment and suggested to analyze the impact of KSA attainment for specific academic year.

Dr. N. R. Deore, Dean, RnD presented Quality Parameter with respective quality parameters

- Quality Publications and Citation Index: 20 Quality Publications
- Patents: No of Patents: Filed 10, Published -10 & Granted 5
- Copyrights Trademarks: Copyrights Filed 10 and Trademark Registered 05
- Student Projects: categorized as Best, Medium, Good and Average.
- Sanctioned Research Proposals with amount by faculty/student: In progress
- Testing and Consultancies with sanctioned amount: In progress with target of 10 lakhs

Dr. Sakhare, Industrialist, appreciated improvement in publications and patent. He suggested focus on center of excellence in future. He added that inclusion of specific domain/specialization in IEEE chapter has scope for improvement. He also recommended interdisciplinary workshops/conferences can be added to boost research collaborations.

Dr. Sonali Patil, HoD, Computer Engineering, mentioned that Blockchain Technology as specialization is added in IEEE.

Mr. Suryakant Jadhav, Alumni, suggested that research on human life is welcomed and scope of patent on human life is explained. He also suggested for commercialization of patents topics like Safety of Patients, Painless treatment, Health and safety can be promoted.

Dean RnD assured more research topics at societal aspects as project that will be suggested in future. Mr. Mandar advised use of LinkedIn to develop Institute-Industry connect and to increase international visibility of PCCoE.

Dr. Rawandale, Dean III, presented achievements with target for placements and internships:

- Number of Companies Visited: 221: -Target is achieved.
- Percentage of students Placed from Eligible students: 73.71
- Highest Package (Lacs)- 53 LPA
- Median Salary (Lacs)- 4.8 LPA
- Number of Companies Offering Internships- 273
- Internship Index- 100%
- Highest Stipend Received by student per month (In Rupess)- 125000 INR

Dr. Deshmukh, Dean SDW, presented Quality Parameters with achievements for Student Development & Welfare:

- Quality of Student Admission: >90%
- Enrollment Ratio:>99%
- Student Participation Index : > 60%
- Student Welfare Index: >60%
- International Student admitted:>80%

Dr. Sakhare, discussed about institutional scholarships, best outgoing student, UG sponsored project and appreciated these practices in PCCoE. He suggested to initiate Best Thesis award for UG, PG and PhD students to promote quality research in the institute.

Dr. Sambhare, Associate Dean, FDW, presented QPs and achievements for faculty development:

- Faculty Qualification with PhD: 50 %
- Qualification of Laboratory supporting staff : 80%
- Faculty Happiness Index: in progress
- Questionnaire is prepared- Feedback/ survey: in progress

Finalization of Happiness Index is in process and frequency of Happiness Index is yearly.

Dr. Rajani PK, Dean IIESD, reviewed IIC Ranking index and outlined Q1 and Q4 activities including Yukti, KAPILA, SIH, Idea competition. Outcome of these efforts PCCoE has received 4-Star rating by Ministry of Education and Government of India for the year 2023-24 with Performance index of 76.92 All efforts by members were well appreciated by the IQAC committee.

Dr. Swati Shinde, Dean MIS, presented Quality Parameters for ERP and Website and also for systems and IT support. She reviewed points

- User Experience and Ease of Access through Survey for ERP
- Website Information categorized as Mandatory Information, Administrative Information, Branding Information, Website Performance
- Numbers of Computers and Configurations
- Internet Bandwidth Mbps to Gbps
- Printing and Scanning services
- Computer Centre

Dr. Sakhare proposed that link for students and parents can be displayed on ERP so that parents will get the information about exams, results, notices etc through institute. Dr. Swati Shinde addressed these practices are already followed in institute.

Mr. Jadhav suggested separate page can be added for Alumini information and interaction. Dean III mentioned about the information of PCCoE Alumni Association "Kalpataru" on PCCoE website.

Mr. Mandar, inquired about computer facility along with printer has to be provided to students. Whereas PCCoE provides printer shared access to the students in laboratories.

Dr. Kolte, Dean LLRD, presented Library Budget Utilization. The discussion was continued based on development of e-content, video lectures and digital resources, utilization hours by faculty and students.

Dr. Sakhare and Mr. Mandar suggested improvements in library access of students which will help in NIRF ranking. Mr. Mandar suggested digital library access to students as modern students are more inclined towards digitization. It was suggested that various competitions like storytelling, write –up, etc can be organized to attract students for book reading.

Similarly Dr. Sambhare presented the proposed code of conducts for all faculty and staff.

IQAC coordinator presented IQAC Activity Planner and approved by all IQAC members
